**Medyria AG successfully closes its Series A Funding Round and Strengthens its Board of Directors**

The round was lead by Fongit SeedInvest SA (FSI), Plan-les-Ouates/GE, and joined by business angels from the StartAngel Network Zurich, the Cantonal Bank of Zurich (ZKB) as well as other private investors.

With the financing round the board of directors will also be strengthened. Dr. Marc Bär and Gian-Luigi Berini, representing the investors, and Eric Le Royer as independent member join founder and CEO Dr. Mauro Sette respectively Giovanni Leo as board members. Mr. Le Royer will serve as chairman of the board.

“We are very excited about the closing of this financing round, as well as the opportunities which are now opening up. The funding will enable us to finalize and accelerate the development of Medyria’s catheter navigation system for endovascular procedures through clinical pathway, regulatory approvals and industrialization. Our goal is to achieve CE-Marking by the end of 2016” said Dr. Mauro Sette.
